**DISSOLUTION
COLE'S FARM WEST HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.**

The Association may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and signed by not less than members entitled to two-thirds (2/3) of the votes of the Association. Upon dissolution of the Association, other than incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Association shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Association was created. In the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed, and assigned to any non-profit corporation, association, trust, or other organization to be devoted to such similar purposes.
