RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS
Section IIB, Reg ency Park of
Williamsburg Plantation

KNOW ALL MED BY THESE PRESENTS, that

WHEREAS, JOHI KOENIG, INC., hemin sometimes called "Owner" or "Developer", is the owner of all that land designated as Section IIB, Regency Park of Williamsburg Plantation, as shown on that certain pat recorded in Book 46. Page 134, in the Office of the Register of Decils of Onslow County North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, Ownr desires to provide stability and appeal in the development of said land;

NOW, THEREFOLE, Owner hereby covenants and agrees to and with all persons, firms, and corporations now owing or hereafter acquiring any of the numbered lots included on said plet, that all of said numbred lots shall be and same now are, to the extent hereinafter defined and described, subject to be following restrictions as to the use there of, running with the said land by whomsoever ownd, to-wit:

1. LAND US: AND BUILDING TYPE: No numbered lot shall be used except for residential purposes. No tructure shall be erected, placed, altered or permitted to remain on any such lot other than one deathed single-family dwelling not to exceed two and one-half stories in height, a private garage fc not more than three (3) cars, with a minimum of one (1) car garage with a parking arron, while garage may contain living quarters for o company by domestic servants of the lot owner city, and such other outbuildings as may be reasonably appurtenant to the dwelling provided thatthe same are constructed in line with the general architectural design and construction standard used in the dwelling itself.

2. <u>DWELLING COST. OUALITY AND SIZE</u>: We sing its family attached or detached dwelling unit shill be permitted on any such lot or lots which shall give to the improved lot or lots on which the said single-family attached or detached dwelling unit is constructed an appraised aluation of less than One Hundred Twenty Thousand and No/100 (\$120,000.00) Dollars; sub valuation to be based upon cost levels prevailing at the date these covenants are recorded; itseing the intention and purpose of this covenant to provide that all dwellings shall be of qualty and workmarship substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the dee these covenants are recorded for the min imum value herein stated for the minimum permitted dwellings size.

No single-story reidence or dwelling unit shall be constructed which shall have a heated area living space of less than 1500 square feet. No two-story residence or dwelling unit shall be constructed which shall have a heated area living space of less than 1500 square feet of which a minimum of 800 square feet shall be the first floor of said two-story dwelling. Heated area living space shall mean the ordinary living space in a house which is to be capable of being besed for regular living use in cold weather. In the computation of floor space, furnace room and exterior storage areas, garage and porches of tall not be counted. No residence may be constructed without a garage. Any plan for construction of a detached garage

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must have the prior approval of the Decloper, as set out in Paragraph 21 of these Restrictive

- 3. PROVISIONS RELATION TO WETLANDS: All of the properties subject to the subject to the following Special Provisions Relating to Wetlans. No person or eatity shall fill, grade, excavte, or perform any other land disturbing on the transfer of the United States of America, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The covenant is intended to ensure continued to provided by the United States of America, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Wilmington District, Action ID 200001107, and therefore may be enforced by the United States of America. This covenant is to run with the land, and shall be binding on the Owner, and all parties caiming under it.
- 4. BUILDING LOCATIOI: The building line of any dwelling house of the buildings appurtement thereto shall notice less than 35 feet from the lot line which the dwelling house fronts. Interior lot line and side/and set-back requirements shall be as provided in the City of Jacksonville and/or Onsiow County Subdivision Regulations governing residential developments. In the event that the realistory boards for the City of Jacksonville and/or Onsiow County Commissioness as a later time dopt a "zero lot line" set back for the development then that ordinance shall apply to this development. Where a garage or other permitted accessory building is incasted within 30 feet of the zer property line, then there shall be a five foot side yard requirement for the rear 30 feet of the zt. A rear yard set-back requirement of 35 feet shall be maintained for those lots abutting othe properties outside this subdivision.

With respect to corner lots, thebuilding line of any dwelling house or unit of the building appartment thereto shall not be less tht 35 feet from the street on which the dwelling house or unit fronts. The provisions of the Cityof lacksonville and/or Onalow County Suit division Regulations governing residential deviconments shall be compiled with in determining the set back from the side street property lineard the required rear yard, if any,

For the purposes of these coverents, exves and steps shall not be considered as a party of the building; provided, however, that his shall not be construed to permit any portion of a building to encreach upon another lot. Open fire escapes, outside stairways, the cordinary projections of chimneys and fines, swinning pools, flag poles, decorative founts and other similar items are not subject to the builting lines at long as the do not obstruct light and ventilation necessary for the structure at the adjoining lot. A variance no more than 10% of the satisfact requirements of this covenantaball be deemed to be in compliance with whe requirements stated herein.

The following covenants are inceded to ensure ongoing compliance with State Stormwater Management Permit Numer 001114, as issued by the Division of Water Quality under NCAC 2H.1000.

The State of North Carolina is nade a beneficiary of these covenants to the extent necessary to maintain compliance with the stormwater management permit.

Those covenants are to run wit the land and be binding on all persons and parties claiming under them.

The covenants pertaining to strmwater may not be altered or rescinded without the express written consent of the State of North Carolina, Division of Water Quality.

The maximum allocable built-upon are per lot is 3,000 square feet. This allotted amount includes any built-upon are constructed within the lot property boundaries, and that portion of the right-of way between the front lot line and the edge of the puvene at. Built upon area includes, but is not limitedto, structures, asphait, concrete, gravel, but it is not limited to not include a sixth area upon decking and between the first property of the maximum property and making a property of the maximum property of the p and parking areas, but doe not include mised, open wood decking, on the water surface of swimming pools.

All runoff from thebuilt-upon areas on the lot must drain into the permitted system. This may be accomplished through providing roof drain guiters which drain to the street, grading the lot to drain toward the street, or grading perimeter swales and directing them into the pond or street. Lots that will naturally drain into the system are not required to provide those measures.

No fence shall be built within the case securit for utilities as so forth in Paragraph S(a) of these coverants. A minimum three-foot extension is the front paragraph S(b) hereof. Focing traversing a lot shall be parallel with the front line. Provided however, that with respects comer lots, no funcing shall be exceed a realization from the back corner of the house (extended from the back line of the house); and in the event a house has shready been established at the lot adjacent to the corner lot, so fencing shall be exceed on the corner lot any closer to thefront of the lot that the distance the front corner of the adjacent structure is from its front roperty line; in any event, fencing shall be an closer than the house's structure is from its front poperly line; in any event, fencing shall be no closer than the house's rear somer. Solid privacy kness over three (3) feet in height shall no t be built within twenty-five (25) feet of a public rist-of-way. Chain link fences of any type are not permitted.

No fences, including decorative split-rail fences, are permitted in the front yard of a lot.

EASEMENT:

- (a) For hilities and Drainage: Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat. Within these easements, no structure, planting or other material shall be placed or memaited to remain which may interfere with the instillation and maintenance of utilities, or which may change the direction or flow or drainage, or which may obstruct or retard the flow of water. All areas indicated as streets and cannents on the recorded plat are hereby ded desired to public use for such uses forever,
- (b) For Inner and Maintenance: The lot owner basing en abutting wall or a wall within five (5) feet othis lot line shall have a five-foot essument along said lot line on adjacent lot owner's property for the purpose of repairs and maintenance of said abutting wall or wall within five feet of theirt line where such repairs and maintenance cannot be accomplished otherwise.
- (c) For Dverhages, Extrassions and Projections: A s to lot owners of adjacent lots which have an abuting wall, essements are reserved over those p ortions of the adjacent lot awner's property that maybe accessary or required to accommodate drainage and utilities and overhanging caves or othe camilevered construction which may ener each upon the adjacent lot owner's property or the ai and light space above such lot owner's property.
- (d) <u>ForUnderground Cables and/or Installation of Street Lighting:</u> The Developer or their Assign reserves the right to subject the real property in this subdivision to a contract with Carolina Power and Light Company or any other utility company for the installation of underground electric cables and/or the installation of street lighting, either or both of which may require an idital payment and/or continuing monthly playment to Carolina Power and Light Company or any other utility company by the owner of each building. Also the County of Oralow may lay special tax assessments against each lot to install street lighting.
- 7. <u>ILLEGALACTIVITY:</u> No illegal, noxious or offens, we activity shall be permitted or carried on an party of raid land, neither shall anything the permitted or done which is or may become a nuisance or a source of embarrasament, discomfort or amongance to the neighborhood. No trash, arbage, rubbish, debris, waste material or other refuse shall be

deposited or allowed to accumulate or emain on any part of said land, or upon any land or lands contiguous thereto. No fires or burning of trash, leaves, elippings or other debris or refuse shall be permitted on any part of said land whout the required permits issued by the appropriate

- 8. ARTESIAN WELLS: to artesian wells may be drilled or maintain ed on any building lot without first obtaining the consent of the Developer. The central water supply system provided for the service of said and shall be used as the sole source of water for all water spigots and outlets located within all buildings and improvements located on each bounding interest for air-conditioning or heating intallation, irrigation purposes, swimming posels or other exterior use. All lots shall be subject toservice charges and free and any and all as sesuments levied in connection with the central water supply system service to the respective subject lots.
- 9. ANIMALS AND LIVESTOCK: No animals, livestock or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on the property, except care, dogs, and other common consended pets and they shall not exceed these (3) of each, provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purposes. Household pets shall not roam freely; they must run min in the yard or, if not in the yard, on a leash.
- 10. AUTOMOBILES, ETC: No automobiles, boats, campers or any other motor vehicle may be diamantled on said property. No mechanically defective automobile or currently tradiscussed automobile studi be placed a allowed to remain on said property over the (10) days. No junked cars shall be placed or allowed to remain on the property. No trailer, mobile home, camper or like recreational vehicle shall be parmitted to remain upon any lot unless it is located so as not to be visible from any street or and within the subdivision.
- 11. OBSTRUCTIONS: The Developer shall have the right, but not the obligation, to remove or require the removal of any face, wall hedge, shrub, bush, tree or other object, natural or smitistial, placed or located on any buding plot, if the location of the same will, in the sole judgment and opinion of the Developer obstruct the vision of a motorist upon any of the access ways.
- 12. REGULATE TRAFFIC: The Developer shall have the right, but not the obligation, from the time to time to courol and regulate all types of traffic on said access ways, including the right to probably use of sal access ways by traffic which, in the sole discretion of the Developer, would or might result identage to said access ways or pavements or other improvements thereon, and the right, by not the obligation to control and prohibit parking on all or any part of said access ways.
- 13. TYPE OF CONSTRUCTON: No building or other improvement away be constructed with an exterior wall finished material of concrete or cinder block types construction or shall be finished in estestos siding singles.
- 14. <u>WINDOW AIR CONDITIONERS</u>: No window air conditioning units shall be installed in a building visible from the sad which the building faces.
- 15. <u>UTILITY</u>: All telephons, electric and other utility lines and connections between the main utility lines and the residence ad other buildings located on each building plot shall be located underground.
- 16. <u>UTILITY COMPANY</u>: The Developer reserves the right to subject the real property in this entire subdivision to a outract with the Carolina Power and Light and/or City of Jacksonville or any other utility company, for the installation of underground elect the cables and/or the installation of street lighting either or both, of which may require a continuing monthly payment from the owner of thelot.
- 17. TYPE OF RESIDENCE No trailer, basement, garage or any outbouilding of any kind, other than a guest house or servar's quarters, even if otherwise permitted he reunder to be or remain on a building lot, shall be used as a residence either temporarily or permanently.



18. <u>DEVELOPER SIGNS</u>: Nothing contained in these covenants and restrictions shall prevent the Developer, approved Builder, or any person designated by the Developer, from execting or maintaining uch commercial or display signs and such stemposary dwelling, model house and other structure as the Developer may deem advisable for development purposes.

19. SIGNS: To sign or signs other than a "For Sale" or "For Rent" sign shall be displayed on the propert, and these signs shall not exceed five (5) square feet total area.

- 20. SWIMMNG POOLS: No swimming pool shall be constructed on any lot unless the proposed location shill have been first approved in writing by it to Doveloper and said pool, with required fence, shall be built in accordance with all applicable. City of Jacksonville and/or Onslow County Zoning Judinances and Regulations. Above grown d pools are not permitted.

21. MAIL BOXES: No mail hox or paper box or other exceptacle of any kind for use in the delivery of mail o newspapers or magazines or similar material shall be erected or located, on any building of unless the size, location and design and type of material for said boxes or receptacles shal have been approved by the Developer. To insure uniformity, the Builder does hareby agre to provide the original mail box post. If at any future thus the post becomes damaged or ha to be replaced for some other reason, it will be replaced with a post of the same size and materil at the owner's expense.

- 22. APPROVAL OF PLANS: No construction shall be sin on any lot, neither shall any building or other innovement be exceed, placed or aftered on plans and specifications and plans showing location of the structure on the individual lot have been approved in writin; by the Developer, its successors or assign s. This approval shall be as to the quality of workmans; and materials, harmony of external design with existing structures, and as to the location with respect to topography and finished guide a devarion. The Developer may delegate its duties uder this paragraph to an architectural committee created for this purpose. Such assignment will be by a document recorded in the or five of the Register of Deeds for Onslow County, Noth Carolina. for Onslow County, Noth Carolina.
- 23. RADIO OF TELEVISION AERIALS: Except as provided below, no radio or television aerial, antennor satellite dish, or any other exterior electronic or electronic equipment or devices of any kind skill be lastalled or maintained on the exterior of any structure located n a building lot or any other position of any building lot. A satellite dist, no greater than eighteen (18) inches in diameter may be installed, as long as it is not visible from the street.
- 24. AMENDMENT OF COVENANTS: These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all prites and all persons chaining under them; for a period of twenty-five (25) years from the database covenants are recorded, after which t an early covenants shall be automatically extended or successive periods of ten (10) years unbears an instrument signed by a majority of the then owners of the lots has been recorded, agreeing to change said covenants in whole or in part. During the first twenty-five (25) year period, then a covenants may be amended in full or in part by an assendment, signed by not less than eighty (\$0%) percent of the owners of the numbered lots. To b effective, any amendment must be recorded. However, the covenants in contained in Paragrap 3 hereinabove are in perpetuity and may express coursent of the Sate of North Carolina and the Department of the Amy Corps of Engineers. Engineers.
- 25. ENFORGMENT: Enforcement shall be by proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any covenant either to restrain violation or recover damages. The Developer of Williamsburg Plantation Homeowner's Association, or any lot sents, shall have the right to enforce, by any proceeding at law or in equity, all restrictions, orditions, reservations, liens and charges now or hereafter imposed by the provision of this Delaration. Failure by the Developer or by a lot owner to enforce any covenants or restriction herein contained shall in no event be deen sed a waiver of the right to do so thereafter.

Reference is also hereby made to the Declaration of Covenants. Conditions and Restrictions recorded in Onelow County Registry, which recording created the Williamsburg Plantation Homeowners Association. Each lot owner in Regency Park of Williamsburg
